Try these twists on games for “kids of all ages” (pssst — that means grown-ups will like them too)!



Marshmallow Madness

Spill mini-marshmallows onto the table. Set a timer for thirty seconds. Using only chopsticks, see who can get the most into his cup (picking up one at a time).

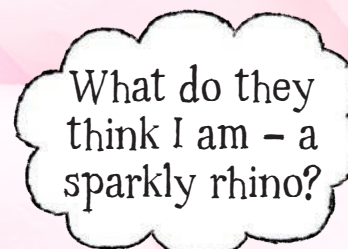
Smarties Suck-Ups

Suck on a straw to make Smarties stick to the bottom. Transfer them to a cup. The winner is the sucker who gets the most Smarties in their cup in the time frame you set (thirty seconds, one minute . . .). Try this with both hands behind your back!



Tumbling Challenges

Tape challenges like “do ten jumping jacks” and “count backwards from 100 by eights” to blocks. Remove a block, do the challenge — until it all comes tumbling down.



Pin the Horn on the Unicorn

Cut out unicorn horns from sparkly paper and put two-sided tape on the back. Draw a horse head on a large piece of paper and tape it to a wall. Blindfold the first player, spin her around, and have her try to pin the horn on the unicorn. Let every player have a turn. The winner is the player whose horn lands closest to the unicorn's forehead.
