“A field trip is when you get to go

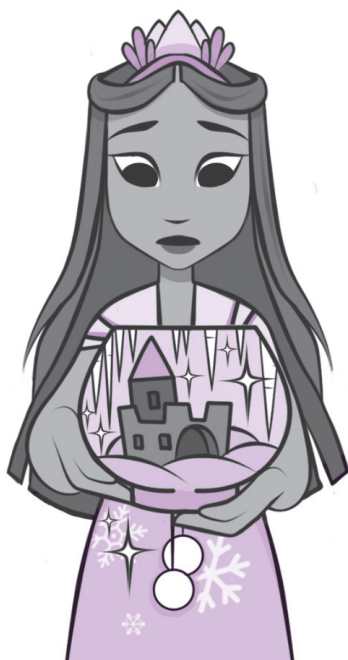


somewhere outside school,” she said.
