

The Never-Ending Story

It's so easy to play, and will keep everyone amused. Start the story with any crazy sentence.



"Once upon a time, there was a dinosaur sitting in a tree."

The next person adds her own sentence.



"It had gas."

Continue until you all collapse in giggles. Listen up and try not to take the story in a predictable direction.

Fortunately, Unfortunately

This storytelling game is similar to the never-ending story, but with one twist. Tellers need to begin each new sentence alternating the words "fortunately" and "unfortunately."

Example: Once upon a time, there was a hairy sasquatch on his way down the mountain when he spied a cute little cottage by the lake. Fortunately, it was a friendly sasquatch. Unfortunately, it was a very hungry sasquatch! Fortunately . . . (The person who ends the story gets the last s'more!)
