



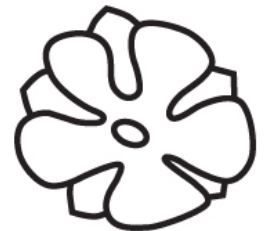
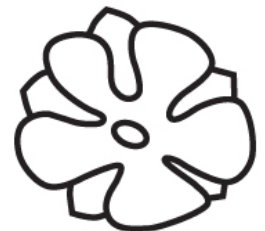
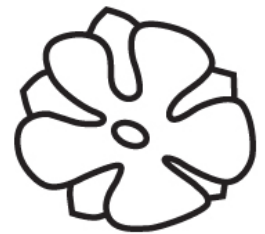
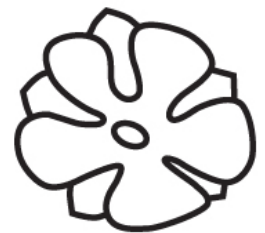
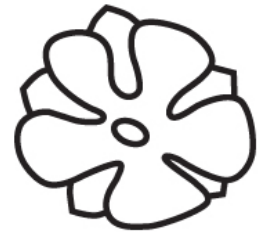
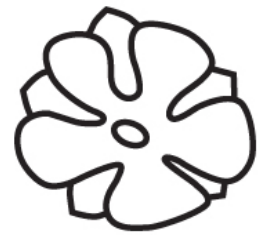
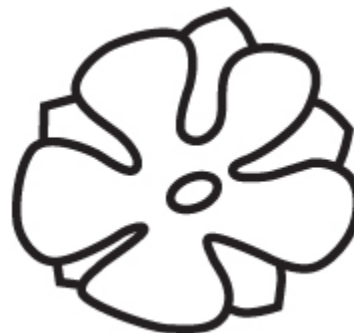
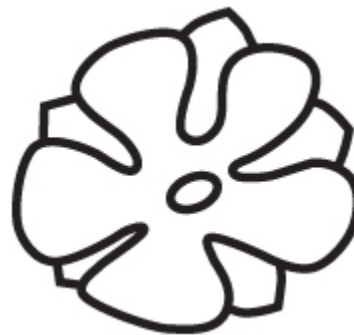
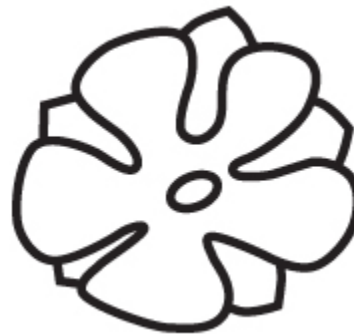
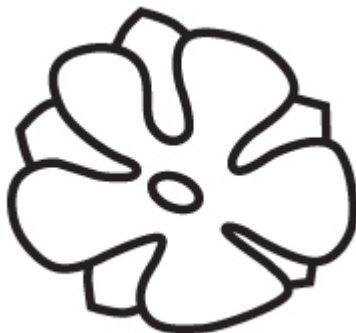
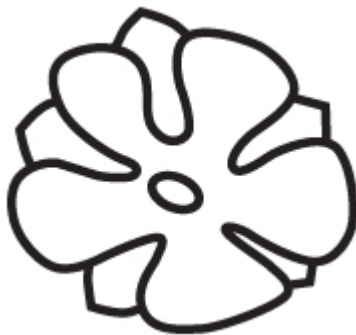
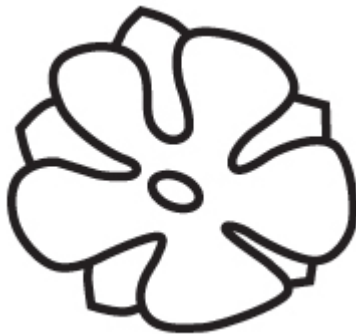
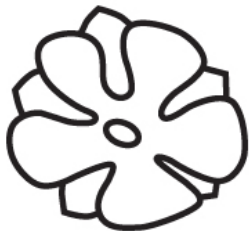
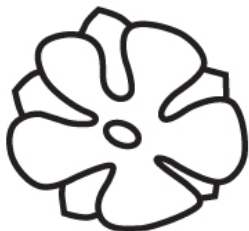
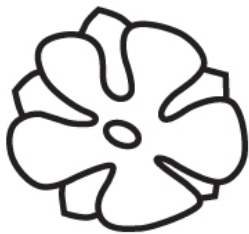
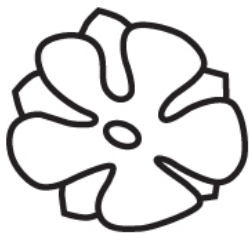
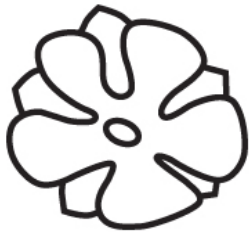
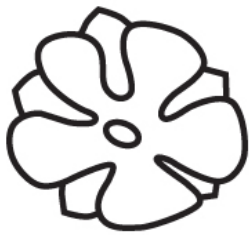
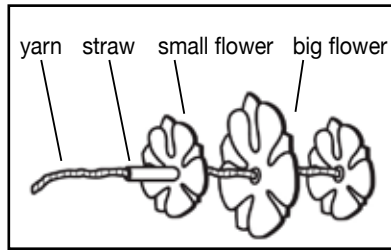
Make a Lei Activity



Attend the Book Fair Luau wearing your own floral lei – a Hawaiian custom of welcome.

Materials required: drinking straw, two pieces of masking tape, 50cm piece of yarn and a one-hole punch.

1. Colour and cut out flower shapes.
2. Use one-hole punch to make a hole in centre of each flower.
3. Cut drinking straw into 4cm lengths.
4. Thread the yarn as shown with one small flower, one big flower, another small flower then a piece of straw. Repeat until all flowers have been used then make a knot at each end of the yarn.
5. Use masking tape to attach an end to your clothing behind each shoulder.



Photocopy and hand out to students to do the activity. Ask students to wear their leis when they visit the Book Fair.
