

Arctic Adventure Goal Chart



Supplies:

- 4' x 8' foam board
- Projector
- Cardboard
- Utility knife
- Hot glue
- Paint
- White stencil letters
- Paintbrushes
- Black Marker
- Meter stick

Directions:

1. Project and trace the goal chart narwhal face (without the horn) on page 2 onto foam board.
2. Paint in the details in the face as shown.
3. Project and trace the horn onto cardboard.
4. Cut out the horn with utility knife. *(For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife — never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.)*
5. Paint the horn white.
6. Use meter stick to draw a clean line across the top of board, then fill in with hot pink paint.
7. Hot glue the horn onto the foam board.
8. Spell out "BOOK FAIR GOAL!" in white stencil letters along top left corner of board.
9. Use meter stick and black marker to create lines and write goal level numbers and "BOOKS SOLD" as shown.
10. As your goals are met, paint in the horn with hot pink paint.
