

# Arctic Adventure Sign Decor



## Supplies:

- Wood post
- Bucket
- Quick dry cement
- Utility knife
- Foam board
- Paint brushes
- Paint
- Duct tape
- Glue
- Quilt batting
- Spray adhesive
- White and black self-adhesive letters or stencil letters

## Directions:

1. Cut the wood post to 5'- 6' tall. Put one end into a bucket and secure into place with quick-dry cement mix. Stabilize the post so it stands up straight while drying in place.
2. Cover the cement with quilt batting.
3. Print and mount the Arctic Adventure Book Fair sign (on page 2) onto foam board. Cut the sign out with a utility knife. *(For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife — never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.)*
4. Cut four rectangular directional signs out of foam board with a utility knife.
5. Using a utility knife, shape the directional signs to look like weathered wood.
6. Paint the directional signs different colors. Allow to dry.
7. Use white or black paint to hand letter the words (or use self-adhesive letters) on the rectangular directional signs.
8. Attach the completed directional signs to the wood post with duct tape or glue.
9. Glue white batting to the tops of the signs to simulate snow.
