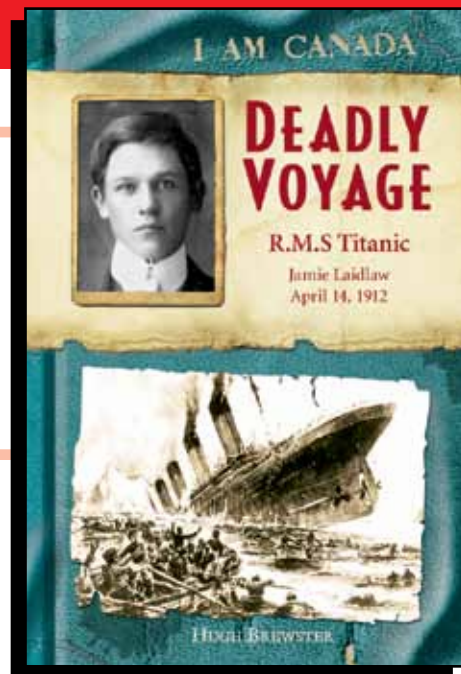

About This Book
