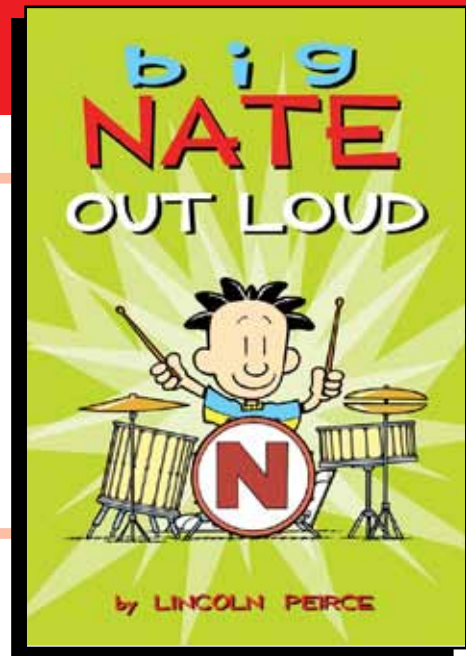
Big Nate Out Loud
