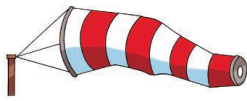

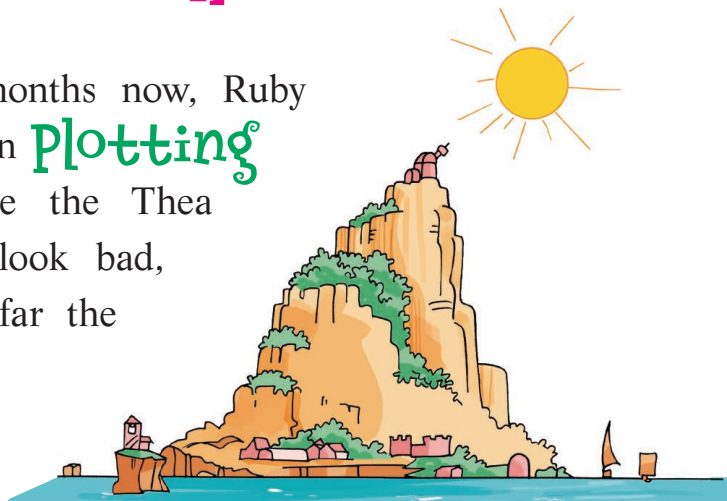


STRANGE SPRING BREEZES

For months now, Ruby had been **plotting** to make the Thea Sisters look bad, but so far the





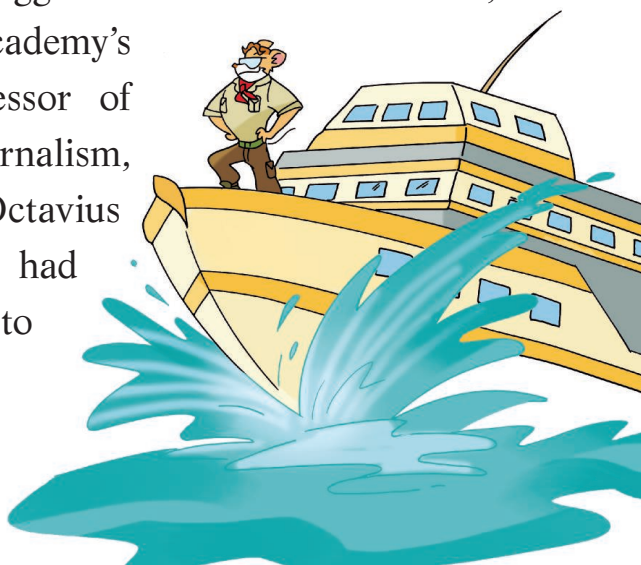


mouselets had foiled all her plans. Ruby was intent on **REVENGE**.
