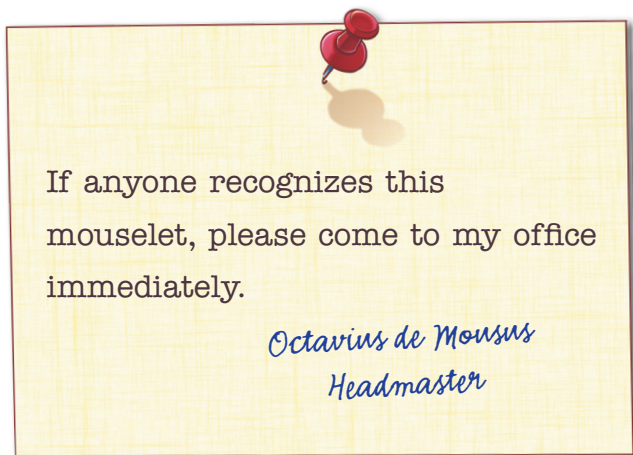
Her friends looked at one another in confusion.
