
Qu'est-ce que la paix?


La vie de mon quartier : Un regard sur ma communauté

Look Where We Live!

In this engaging non-fiction picture book, five young friends spend the day traveling around their neighbourhood and participating in activities designed to raise money for their local library. Along the way, they learn about the people and places that make up their community and what it means to be a part of one.

Each spread features a different location, detailed in a bright, busy illustration that expands on its connections to the community. Author and illustrator Scot Ritchie has created a rich resource for social studies lessons on places, roles and jobs within a community, and what it takes to be a responsible citizen. There is also potential for broader classroom discussions, including the economy of a community, geography and mapping, and how the concepts of cooperation, responsibility and teamwork apply. The author has also included step-by-step instructions for a puzzle-making project.
