FASCINATING FACTS

- **Bees:** The 'killer bee' species was created in Brazil in 1956 by the crossbreeding of African and European bees.
- **Boogers:** Slugs and snails coat themselves in a horrid-tasting mucus, so that birds don't eat them.
- **Glass:** When lightning strikes sand, it heats it up enough to melt it into long, branching tubes of glass known as fulgurites.
- **Math:** Early number systems didn't have a symbol for zero used at the end of a number, which made it hard to tell numbers like 6 and 60 apart.
- **Nurses:** The first known professional nurses were employed by Ancient Egyptian priests 5000 years ago to care for their patients and were nearly all male.
- **Trees:** Firewood was our very first source of energy, and 2 billion people around the world still depend on wood energy for cooking and heating, particularly in developing countries.

What Are Boogers and Snot?

Boogers are dried nasal mucus (mucus that forms in the nose). Nasal mucus (or snot) is produced by glands called goblet cells in your nasal passages. How does it become dry? When people breathe in, especially during the winter, they inhale dry air. That's one way that boogers form. They can also form when nasal mucus traps particles in the air. The mucus dries around the particle and hardens, a bit like a pearl forming around a grain of sand in an oyster. Capturing particles is what mucus is supposed to do. So having boogers just proves that your nose is working well.

NOSE EGGS CAN BE HARD, BUT...they are boogers!

When those juncos in power are slaying, that's snot!

SNOUT COLOR CHART. The color of your snot can tell you a lot about your health. Check out this chart.

WHITE SNOT: You are congested. Inflamed blood vessels in the nose are slowing the flow of the mucus, so it loses moisture.

YELLOW SNOT: You have a cold. White blood cells are rushing to the site of the infection.

GREEN SNOT: Your immune system is fighting back. The mucus is thick with dead white blood cells, turning the snot green.

PINK OR RED SNOT: Blood vessels in your nose have broken. The mucus may be from too much rubbing, blowing, or picking.

BROWN SNOT: You have probably inhaled some dirt.

BLACK SNOT: You may have a serious lung infection. Seek medical attention.

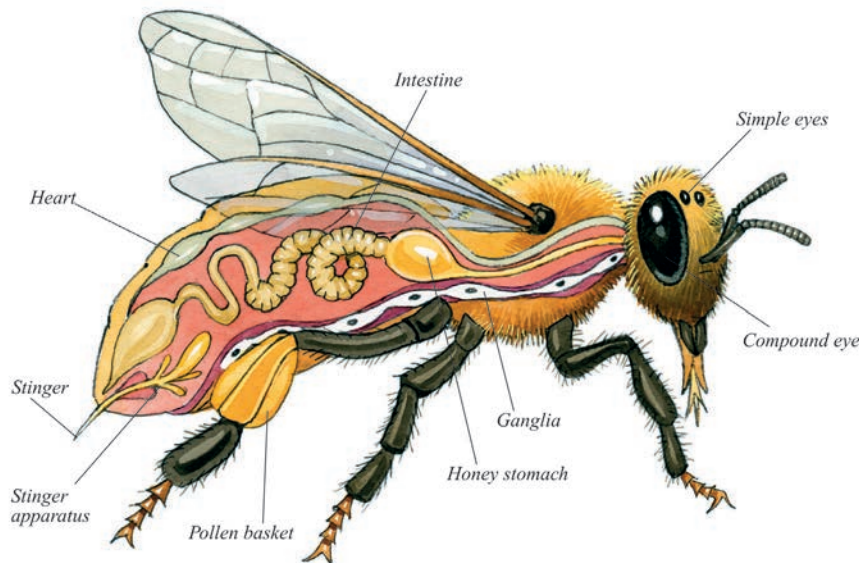
PHLEGM is a mixture of mucus, saliva, and white blood cells. It's produced by the lower airways such as the windpipe and the lungs. You don't normally notice phlegm until you get sick and you cough it up.

Make your own fake snot.

- Add 2 tablespoons of gelatin, then stir.
- Add ½ cup of room temp. then stir.
- Let it cool to form slushy, sticky snot.
