T— is used to getting grief. Grief from his mother, who worries about him constantly; grief from Mr. Lam, who runs the corner store and suspects every kid of stealing; grief from the trio of bullies he calls Joined at the Hip, whose cruelty has left T— so battered he fears even his whole name could be used against him.

When Lucy is attacked by Joined at the Hip, T— captures the assault on film. But those images lead him into even deeper trouble with the bullies, who threaten to hurt Sean if T— tells.

What's the right thing to do? Do pictures ever tell the whole truth? And what if the truth isn't always the right answer?

Born and raised in Montreal, **EMIL SHER** taught at a secondary school in rural Botswana before returning to Canada to pursue a degree in creative writing. Emil has written professionally ever since: stage plays, screen plays, non-fiction and children's fiction including *Mittens to Share*, illustrated by Irene Luxbacher. While his plays, including *Hannah's Suitcase*, have been widely produced in schools, *Young Man With Camera* is his first novel. Emil currently lives in Toronto, Ontario with his family.

A NOTE FROM VIKKI VANSICKLE:

On Friday nights in grade seven you could find me in the basement, in the dark, watching *The X-Files*. Conspiracy theories? Loved them. Alternate histories? Couldn't get enough. My obsession culminated in a friend and me attending an *X-Files* convention wearing FBI badges made in Microsoft Paint — hers said Mulder, mine said Scully — at which I got up in front of a conference room full of much older “X-Philes” and a panel of screenwriters to pitch my idea for an episode.

At first glance, *The Winnowing* might seem at odds with my previous work. Essentially I'm exploring my perennial themes — relationships, coming of age — set in a world that *could* have been. I'm interested in what ordinary people do in extraordinary situations. What if you don't want to save the world, you just want to save your friend? *The Winnowing* is a love letter to *The X-Files* and the worlds and concepts that show opened up for me. But it's also about the everyday, inescapable conflicts of adolescence: fighting with your best friend, working with your arch-nemesis, worrying about your appearance, and wondering where you fit in the world.

Oh, and that *X-Files* pitch session I entered back in 1995? I won.



EXCERPT FROM *THE WINNOWING*:

I'm flying.

At least that's what it feels like. What I'm really doing is running. But it's the smoothest, easiest action in the world, like I was born to do nothing but run. I barely feel the ground below me.

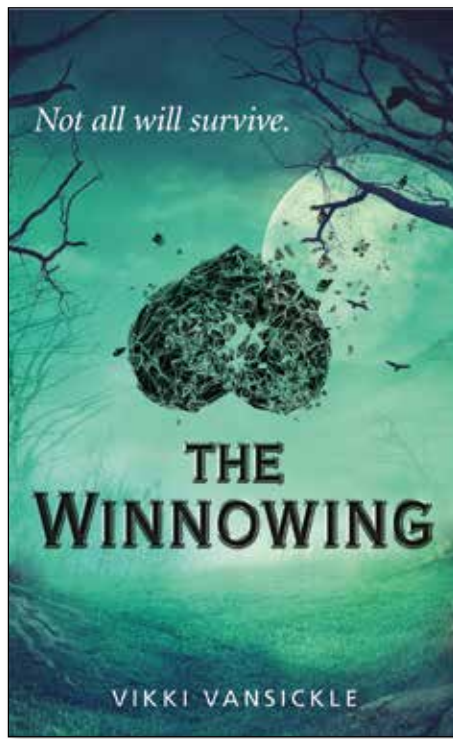
I could burst into song and keep on running without breaking my stride.

First, it gets hot. Stinging sweat drips into my eyes. I rub at them with the back of my knuckles, which only makes them sting more. When I blink the tears away I find myself lost in smoke so thick I can't see my own hands in front of me. Then I lose my footing. I fall on my knee, hard. I look down and it isn't grass and dirt below me but thick, black gunk, glowing red like the embers in the belly of a campfire. It swirls around my feet and hands, lapping at my wrists and ankles.

I push myself up, palms stinging, and I keep running.

I run and run but I can't get ahead of the lava. It roils and burps, splashing my calves with burning drops. I hear screaming and the stampeding of feet behind me but I don't dare slow down to see what's happening. I try to run faster but the lava swirls higher around my ankles. Something is burning and I know it must be my own flesh that's making that horrible smell, but I don't want to believe it. I can't. I'm screaming for help and then—
