





## **Button Wreath**

**Materials needed:** Poster board or cardboard, preferably white, scissors craft glue, holiday ribbon, assorted buttons in a range of colors and sizes, 6 inch length of string.

For Wreath Base: Use a circular object the size of your desired wreath to trace a circle onto a piece of cardboard or poster board. Or, you might also use something already circular like a plastic coffee can lid. Cut a hole out of the middle of your circle to make a donut/wreath shape.

Punch a small hole in the top of your wreath shape and pass the string through it. Tie the ends together to form a loop.

Now, for the fun: Have your child help you chose button colors for your wreath. All red, white and green for Christmas? White and blue for Chanukah? Or all different colors for a festive look!

Glue buttons one by one to the wreath frame.

Once the wreath frame is covered with buttons, and the glue is dry, tie a bow on it with the holiday ribbon.

Hang the wreath on a Christmas tree, in a window, or from a doorknob. Or, as a final touch, glue a photo on to the back and use the wreath to frame a favorite photo!
