

How Do Dinosaurs Say I'm Mad?

By Jane Yolen Illustrated by Mark Teague I say this every time Jane Yolen and Mark Teague put out a new How Do Dinosaurs book, but this one might be my favourite. Above a dinosaur who sticks out his tongue, Yolen asks: "How does a dinosaur act when he's mad?" Anger is presented in a silly way, showing children that acting out might not be the best outlet. Anger can be difficult to talk about with your child, but even when little dinosaurs are furious, it's important to help them handle their feelings and remind them they are always loved. Here is the perfect way to say, "I'm sorry and I love you."
