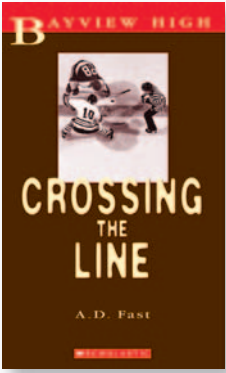
1. What were Jack's injuries from the hockey game? (pp. 20–25)
