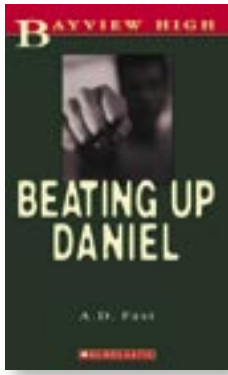
Beating Up Daniel
