Working with Words—Cause and Effect

Cause and effect is the relationship between any action and its result.

For example:

Justin studied for his geography test so he got 90 percent.

Cause: Justin studied

Effect: got 90 percent.

Give the cause and effect for each of the following sentences:

1. Monday morning Justin was tired from staying up late to complete his geography assignment.

2. Travis was confident about the exam because he was sitting near Justin.

3. Dean was frustrated so Mr. Thomas took him in the hallway to complete his exam.

4. Justin panicked because he had not finished reading *Catcher in the Rye*.

5. When Justin saw Travis looking at his paper he moved his arm across the desk to block his answers.
