### Working with Words—Compound Personal Pronouns

- (a) compound—two words
- (b) pronoun—word that stands for a noun
- (c) personal—referring to a person or thing

A compound personal pronoun ends in –self or –selves.

For example:

ourselves    themselves    itself

yourselves    myself    himself

herself    yourself
