## Working with Words—Asking Questions

Reporters working on a story need to ask many questions to gather the facts. It is important for them to ask open-ended questions to get complete information.

Open-ended questions allow for the possibility of detailed responses.

Closed questions often elicit a “yes” or “no” answer.

For example: Do you like cheeseburgers?
