






The World on a Globe

A globe shows all of Earth. You can see Earth's continents and oceans on a globe.

The **equator** is an imaginary line that circles the globe halfway between the North and South poles. The equator divides Earth into two halves called **hemispheres**. The northern half is the Northern Hemisphere. What do you think the southern half is called? Earth can also be divided into Western and Eastern Hemispheres. Study the hemispheres on the globes.
