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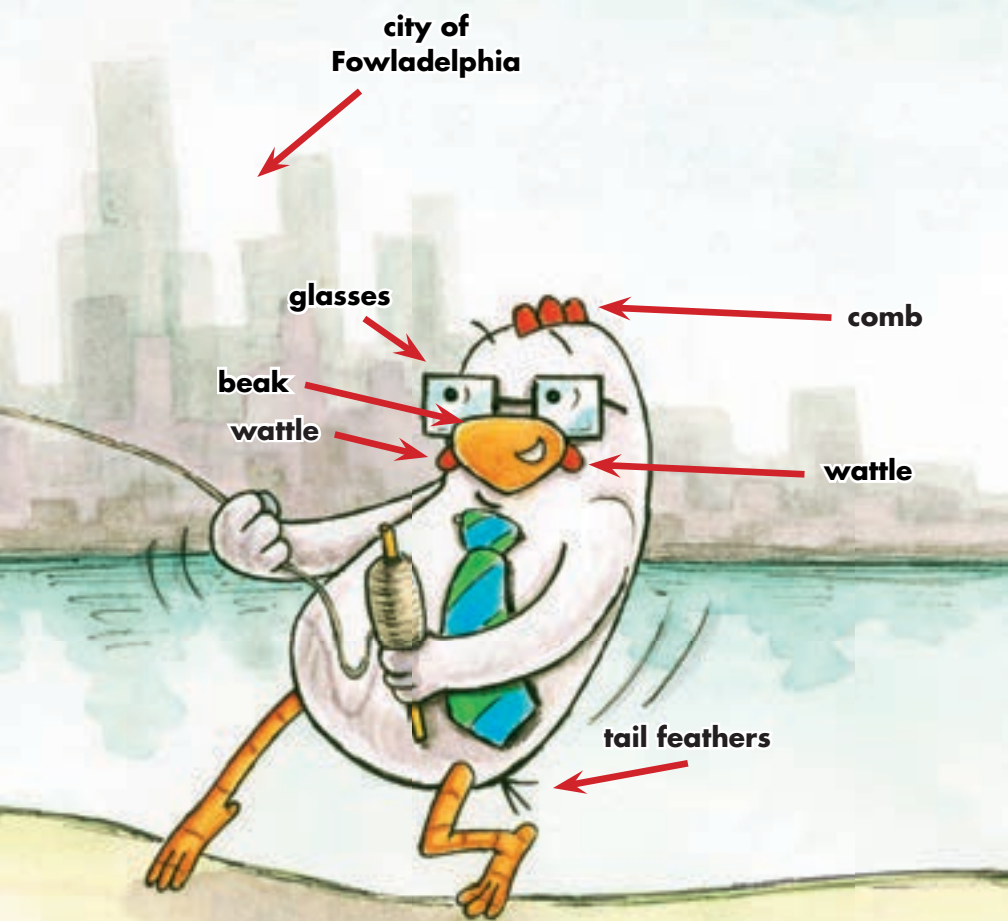

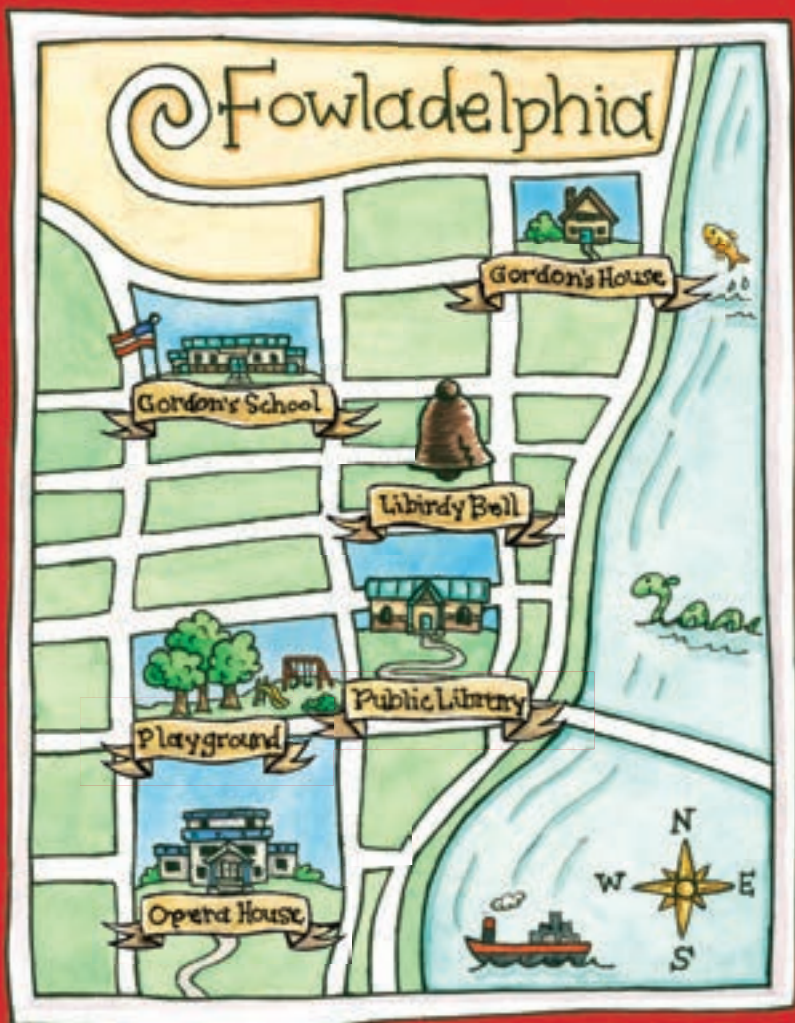
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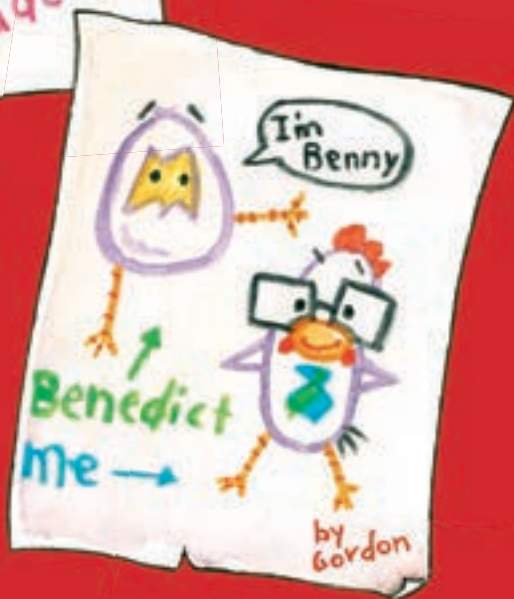
Gordon Blue seemed like an ordinary chicken.

The toxic sludge was no ordinary toxic sludge. It had given Gordon superpowers.

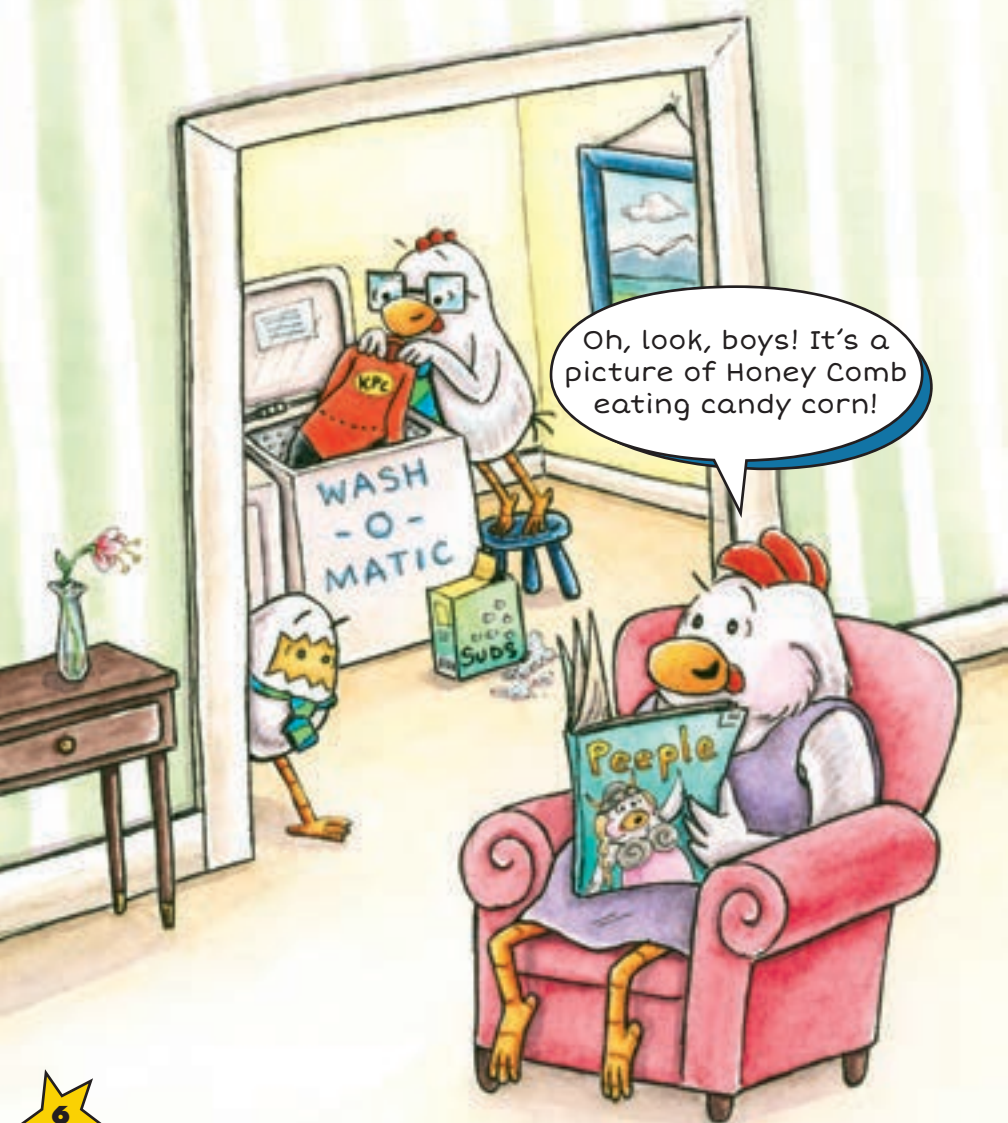


Sidekicks have powers, too!

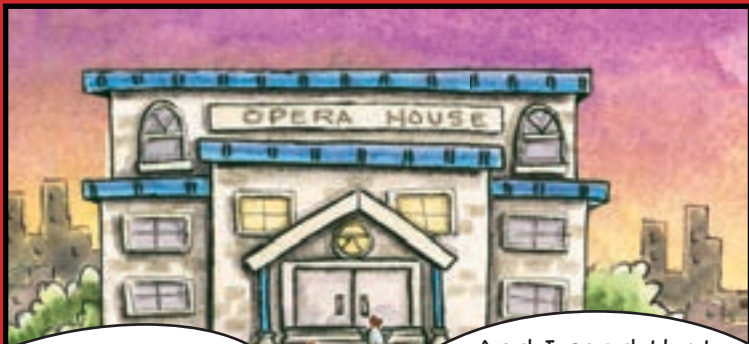
