
Where'd the Puck Go?

The Stanley Cup series between the Ottawa Silver Seven and Rat Portage Thistles in March 1903 was played during unusually warm weather that left the playing



surface in terrible shape. At one point during the first game of the series, the puck fell through a hole in the ice and disappeared!



The Edmonton Oilers won all five of their Stanley Cups on home ice.

Clint Benedict holds the career record for shutouts in Stanley Cup games. Benedict recorded eight shutouts during the five Stanley Cup series he played with the Ottawa Senators and Montreal Maroons in the 1920s. Benedict is also one of only three goalies to post three shutouts in a single Stanley Cup Final. Here's a look at the complete list:
