
Square Bubbles

Blow a square bubble? Yes, you can!

You'll Need

- 4 pipe cleaners
- straw
- bubble solution (see page 76)
- 1. Bend two of the pipe cleaners into squares.
- 2. Ask an adult for help to cut one of the remaining pipe cleaners into three equal parts. Use each of the three short pieces to connect the squares together in three corners.
- 3. Use the fourth pipe cleaner to connect the last two corners of the squares together, leaving the extra length as the handle.
- 4. Fill a bowl with enough bubble solution to cover the cube. Dip the cube in so all six sides get a bubble film on them.
- 5. Shake the cube gently after you remove it from the solution. The soap film on its sides will collapse to form a square bubble in the centre of the cube!
- 6. Dip the straw into the bubble solution, then use it to gently blow a bubble into the square. When the bubble sticks to the square, a cubical bubble will form in the centre of the pipe cleaner cube!



In a Bubble

Pour some of your bubble solution in a kiddie pool. Lay a hula hoop in it. Stand inside the hoop and lift it straight up. If you're lucky, you'll find yourself inside a giant bubble!
