Together they plant a milkweed garden to feed and shelter the tiny creatures, then watch in amazement as a monarch hatches and grows before leaving on the long journey to Mexico. After all the butterflies have departed, Maya shares her own migration story — her family's long journey to Canada. Maya wishes the monarchs safety in their new home too.

In her heartwarming final story, Jean Little weaves a simple tale of childhood curiosity into larger themes of immigration, friendship and the wonder of the natural world.

JEAN LITTLE has been called "a Canadian treasure." She wrote more than fifty books including some of Canada's best-loved children's books, such as *From Anna, Listen for the Singing, Mine for Keeps, Orphan at my Door* and *Pippin the Christmas Pig.* Many of her books feature children who are orphaned, have a disability, or face other challenges. Jean's books have been translated into a dozen languages and have won many awards, including a Canadian Library Association Book of the Year award, the Ruth Schwartz Award, the Canada Council Literature Prize, and the Boston Globe Horn-Book Honor Book Award. She was honoured with the Vicky Metcalf Award for her body of work, the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal and the Orre of Canada and was nominated for the international Astrid Lindgren Award eight times. Jean died in 2020.







Lacey never puts her clothes in the laundry hamper, until once morning she goes to get dressedfor school and she finds she has ... no clean clothes!

Her mom tells Lacey to wear a shirt her grandma gave her -a weird one that says: "Kiss me, I'm perfect!" Lacey just knows the other kids are going to make fun of her.

On the way to school, Lacey meets a cat, a dog, and an eagle. They all read her T-shirt, then give her a kiss! Then she meets a moose, who gives her a large wet moose kiss, right up the front of her face and over the top of her head. Lacey is thrilled – maybe this shirt is wonderful, not weird! But when her classmate reads the shirt and gives her a peck on the cheek: YUCK! BOY KISS!

Robert Munsch wrote this story for a girl from Stewart, B.C., a place full of all the wildlife in the book! The day he visited the school there, the kids could not go out for recess because there were two grizzly bears on the playground. Lacey was in grade one and was wearing a t-shirt that said, "KISS ME, I'M PERFECT!" This classic Munsch tale is now reissued with a bright new cover design.

ROBERT MUNSCH started telling stories when he was teaching in a daycare, to get the kids to settle down. Now he is Canada's number one author for young readers with more than 80 books in print, including such bestsellers as *The Paper Bag Princess*(*La princesse dans un sac*), *We Share Everything!*(*On partage tout!*), *So Much Snow!* (*La tempête du siècle*) and *Love You Forever*. Every one of his stories was first told aloud to children – and each one is dedicated to the kid who inspired the story. He is a member of the Order of Canada, has a star on Canada's Walk of Fame, and is a hero to generations of young readers. Robert Mnsch lives in Guelph, Ontario.
