BEN CLANTON is the creator of the graphic novel series *Les aventures de Narval et Gelato*. His picture books include *Patate Pourrie : Le légume le plus mignon du monde!* and *Patate Pourrie : Le légume le plus courageux du monde!* Ben lives in Seattle, Washington.

COREY R. TABOR grew up in Wyoming, where he once spent the night in a cave by an underground waterfall. He now lives with his wife in Seattle, Washington, where he draws and reads and explores.

ANDY CHOU MUSSER is the author-illustrator of *A Home Under the Stars*, his debut picture book, which received a starred review from *Kirkus Reviews* and a silver medal from the Society of Illustrators of Los Angeles. He lives on a cozy hill in Seattle, Washington, not far from wild forests and magical woodland creatures.


Author Sara O'Leary and illustrator Qin Leng have created a delightful, heartfelt, inclusive book about making and being a friend — the final title in their trilogy.







Walking Together

This bestselling, innovative picture book introduces readers to the concept of *Etuaptmumk* — or Two-Eyed Seeing, the gift of multiple perspectives in the Mi'kmaq language — as we follow a group of young children connecting to nature as their teacher.

A poetic, joyful celebration of the Lands and Waters as spring unfolds: we watch for Robin's return, listen for Frog's croaking, and wonder at maple tree's gift of sap. Grounded in *Etuaptmumk*, also known as Two-Eyed Seeing, which braids together the strengths of Indigenous and non-Indigenous ways of knowing, and the Mi'kmaq concept of *Netukulimk*, meaning to protect Mother Earth for the ancestors, present, and future generations, *Marchons ensemble* nurtures respectful, reciprocal, responsible relationships with the Land and Water, plant-life, animals, and other-than-human beings for the benefit of all.

ELDER DR. ALBERT D. MARSHALL is from the Moose Clan of the Mi'kmaq Nation, Eskasoni First Nation in Unama'ki-Cape Breton, Nova Scotia. A fluent speaker of Mi'kmaq, he has brought forth the concept of *Etuaptmumk*/Two-Eyed Seeing which honours the strengths of both Indigenous and non-Indigenous knowledges and ways of knowing for the benefit of all.

LOUISE ZIMANYI, who is of French-Canadian and Hungarian descent, lives as a guest in TkaronTO/Toronto, Treaty 13 territory. As a professor and researcher, she is co-learning from and with the Land and wise teachers, co-transforming early childhood pedagogy and practice.

EMILY KEWAGESHIG is an Anishinaabe artist and visual storyteller whose work captures the interconnection of life forms using both traditional and contemporary materials and methods. She creates artwork that highlights Indigenous knowledge and culture. Emily is from Saugeen First Nation in Ontario, Canada.

When Saoussan immigrated with her family from war-torn Lebanon, she was only seven years old. This picture book tells the story of how she had to adjust to her new home in Canada. She describes the frustration of not understanding the teacher when she started school, not knowing how to ask to go to the bathroom, and being terrified of a Halloween skeleton. This is the perfect book to help kids empathize with immigrant children whose experiences are very similar to Saoussan's.

ROBERT MUNSCH started telling stories when he was teaching in a daycare, to get the kids to settle down. And, today, Monster declares, he will not walk to school. Will Bird's cajoling help? Nope. How about Bird's reminder that the pancake breakfast is today? Hmm. Will there be pepperoni and pineapple on those pancakes? Erm...yes? With maple syrup on the side? Yes. Okay. Monster will drag himself out the door. But, no matter what, he will not walk to school!


This hilarious story, told entirely in speech balloons, is sure to resonate with young children everywhere (and their grown-ups!). Kelly Collier's playful illustrations perfectly capture the emotional state of Monster and of Bird's growing exasperation.

While books about going to school are perennial favourites, this one's focus on simply getting there sets it apart from other picture books about school readiness.
