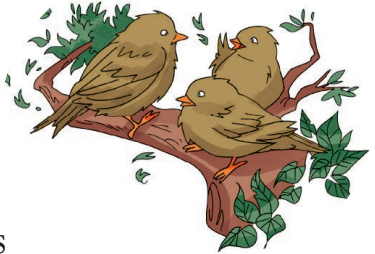
# SPRING FEVER STRIKES AT MOUSEFORD!
