And the cat next door had gone inside.

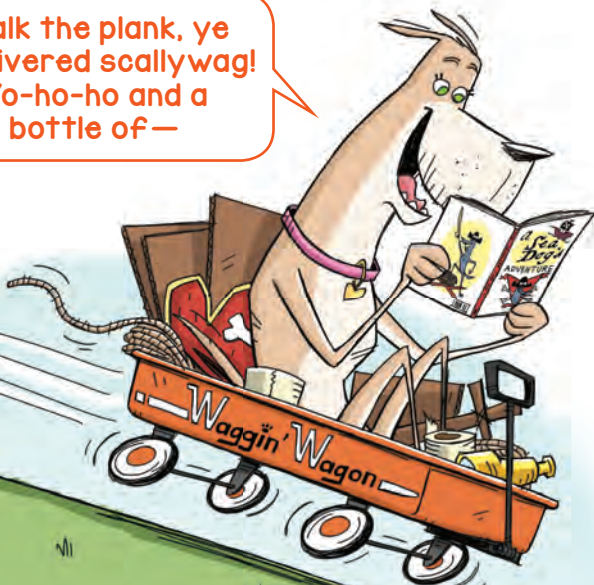
Tank was not bored.
