# Fox and Squirrel – Colour and play the matching game

# **Print, Colour, Cut, Play!**

#### You will need:

- 8 ½" x 11" paper or card-stock
- Scissors
- Step 1: Print the illustration page on 8 ½" x 11" paper or card stock
- **Step 2:** Colour all the images. Remember to colour the matching ones the same!
- **Step 2:** Using scissors, cut out all the cards along the dotted lines.
- **Step 3:** Mix up the pictures and place them all on a table facing down.

#### PLAY!

### **Option 1: One player**

Select two cards and turn them over. If the cards match, move them to the side and flip over two more cards. If the cards don't match, place them back and try again. The game ends when you have matched all of the pairs!

## **Option 2: Play with a friend**

The first player selects two cards and turns them over. If the cards match, the player collects them and plays again. If player 1 turns over cards that don't match, then player 2 begins his or her turn. The game is over when there are no more cards on the table. The player with the most matching sets of cards wins!
